Marwadi, some Kannad and Gujarati. Both of the Samnijis are disciples of ACHARYA – Acharya Pravar Shri Shubhchandraji Maharaj Saheb; UPADHYAYA – Upadhyaya Pravar Shri Parshvachandraji Maharaj Saheb; GURU –Dr. Shri Padamchandraji Maharaj Saheb. Samnijis are educated in Jainology (one with BA, other with MA - Gold Medalist), Naturopathy and Prakrit.

While they can be considered as a very good resource to reach out to various age groups, they can also have a strong impact on the youths & teenagers. Though they come under Sthanakwasi parampara, they have no barriers about any sampradaya or parampara and are open to any public under the Jain aegis as well across other practices that may be interested to hear and experience the teachings of Jainism.  - 3. Art and science of eating Digest your food and digest your thoughts
 - 4. Awaken yourself from within Door to self-realization
 - 5. As you sow, so you reap Theory of karma and its scientific perspective
 - 6. Body never lies Body has its own way of teaching a lesson in life (with a small meditation of Jain Anuppeha Dhyan Yog Sadhana)
 - 7. Prayer Heals Discover the healing powers of prayer
 - 8. Power of Giving Jain way and science behind it
 - 9. Forgiveness Meditation "Forgiving yourself can create wonders in life
 - 10. Earn a living, Earn a merit, Recieve happiness, Attain Moksha
 - 11. Family and its importance in life
 - 12. Jainism and Science
 - 13. Jainism Mudras and Parashakti
